602 SPORTSMAN MODIFIED RULES

**CHASSIS :** Traditional Modified chassis shall be used ( Example : Bicknell, Teo, Troyer, DKM, Etc...) All cars must have dirt style intrusion bars installed.

**BODIES :** Dirt or STSS legal bodies allowed. NO WINGS, SAIL PANELS, OR ANY TYPE OF OUTLAW BODY WILL BE ALLOWED. All bodies must be a traditional style modified body. The use of a spoiler is permitted. Traditional style rub rails only.

**ENGINES :** Sealed GM 602 crate engines ONLY. NO OPEN OR BUILT ENGINES WILL BE PERMITTED. All 602 crate engines must be verified for use in 2024. Check for a Certified dealer in your area.

**REV BOX :** All cars must be equipped with part number MSD8727CCT rev box. Rev box MUST be set to 6000 maximum RPM at all times.

**FUEL/CARBURETOR :** Commercially available pump gas or racing gas will be allowed. NO OXYGENATED FUELS ALLOWED. Carburetor MUST be gauge legal Holley 650 CFM Part #80541-1, 80541-2, or Holley 650 #4777 Only. No tapered carburetor spacers. Must be open hole only.

**EXHAUST HEADERS AND MUFFLERS :** Muffler and exhaust systems are required. NO stainless steel or exotic metals. NO Tri Y collectors. Or stainless steel exhaust will be permitted. ALL CARS MUST HAVE MUFFLERS

**SHOCKS :** Steel body shocks only. No rebound adjustable or canister style shocks.

TIRES : Hoosier Tires ONLY. Hoosier D300, D400, D500 tires shall be used on all corners of the car. NO block tread late model or sprint car tires allowed. Chemically altering of tires is NOT permitted.

WEIGHT : All cars MUST weigh 2400 lbs after heat race and after feature race. Track scales are final for all weight measurements. All ballast must be secured by at least 2 half inch bolts and painted white with car number clearly marked.

SAFETY : All drivers must wear an SFI rated fire suit, shoes, and gloves. Helmet must be a SA2010 rated or newer.

- Seat belts must be SFI rated and within expiration date
- Seats must be bolted in a minimum of 6  $\frac{3}{8}$ " bolts with fender washers
- Fuel cell must have a flapper valve and an in-line shut off within drivers reach
- Fire suppression system is highly recommended
- Head and Neck restraints are highly recommended
- Full containment seats are highly recommended
- Transponders and driver radios are covered in General Track Rules
